He is a Chief of Irkutsk Branch of Russian Society of Epidemiology, Microbiology and Parasitology and a Member of Russian Geographical Society. An author of > 300 scientific papers, Prof. Botvinkin is an Editorial Board Member in *Siberian Journal of Medicine*.
