Research interests of Prof. Dr. Vladimir I. Zlobin are molecular epidemiology and prevention of encephalitis, poliomyelitis, and other tick-borne infections. He comprehensively analyzed the strains of tick-borne encephalitis virus in Russia and also participated in the development of the test systems for the diagnostics of arbovirus and flavivirus infections. Prof. Zlobin is a Laureate of Zhdanov Prize in Molecular Virology and Robert Koch Medal. He is a Deputy Chief of the Russian Academy of Sciences Committee on Viral Encephalitis and a Member of the respective committees on zoonoses, arboviruses, and infectious diseases. As a WHO Consultant, Prof. Zlobin worked in Bulgaria, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, North Macedonia, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, and Turkmenistan. An author of > 700 scientific papers, he is an Editorial Board Member in *Problems in Virology, Epidemiology and Vaccine Prevention, Applied Entomology, Siberian Journal of Medicine*, and *Journal of Infectious Disease Pathology*.
